Blank Center for Safe and Healthy Children and the virtual Institute on Healthcare and Human Trafficking have a new online webinar to educate school personnel on the impact of human trafficking. This training is designed to meet the requirements for teacher education on child sexual abuse included in Senate Bill 401. The course covers:

- The risk factors, potential indicators, and health consequences of child sex trafficking
- Common recruitment techniques
- Strategies school professionals can use to prevent exploitation of students
- Appropriate places to refer children they suspect have been or are at risk of being trafficked
